Who can apply as a mentee?

First year students of the SBS master programme in Operations Management & Control.

What will you get out of it?

The programme is a unique possibility for SBS Operation Management & Control students to expand their network and gain insight and knowledge about Swedish and international business realities and career possibilities. Students will also gain greater confidence in approaching the labour market upon completing their studies.

What is expected of you as a mentee?

- Your mentor and the programme are there to support you but it is your responsibility as a mentee to get the maximum value from the mentoring process
- You have a joint responsibility together with your mentor to keep in contact and book meetings
- You need to prepare for the mentor programme by formulating an overall goal for your participation
- You need to transform the advice from your mentor into a concrete action plan to reach your goals

Application Process

The application must be written in English and consist of three parts: a personal letter, your CV, and a transcript of your grades. Please send your application to mentorOPC@sbs.su.se the latest by 22 January 2019! See www.sbs.su.se/industrymentorprogramme for more details.

The mentor programme 2019 is tentatively scheduled to start with a kick-off meeting at the end of February 2019. If you are accepted to the programme, you will be matched with a mentor based on your application and the available mentor profiles (by mid-February 2019). The programme will run for twelve months in which you and your mentor will meet individually approximately once per month. There will also be joint meetings and workshops organised around special themes, where SBS and One Academy will invite guest lecturers. The mentoring programme will mainly run in English, but some parts may also be in Swedish.

Please clearly express why you apply to the programme in your personal application letter. The number of mentee positions is limited to 8-10. Only applications that have been sent before the deadline will be considered. Before the programme starts, selected candidates will be required to sign a mentee agreement ensuring their commitment to the programme.
